Zoning Report Carolyn Sims

- ZI Sims presented the Westfield Terrace plat for Phase I for the Trustee signatures as provided by Mr. Bennett and approved by the BZA on July 26, 2017. This is the July 13, 2017 print of the documents. Signatures are good for 60 days. Phase 1 will be for 28 lots. The recent activity relates to adding storm water collection, expanding the retainage pond and additional grading. Mr. Bennett was thanked for his patience by the Trustees.
- Five (5) zoning certificates were issued for 6831 Buffham Road, Ryan Road and Greenwich Road. This includes 3 new houses and 2 Pole Barns.
- ZI Sims will provide a comprehensive zoning certificate issuance report and this will also be provided to the County Auditor as required.
- As a follow up the North Coast Soccer public records request, it was determined that the audio for the June 5, 2017 is the last remaining item to be submitted.
- Trustee Schmidt and ZI Sims observed during soccer activity that North Coast Soccer was in compliance with their permitting.
- A Zoning Committee Meeting will take place on September 7, 2017 at 6:30 PM regarding the Greenwich Road Text Amendment.
- ZI Sims & Zoning Secretary Porter cleaned up their files and presented FO Evans with the files for review and destruction per the policy.

Road Report

- Lee Evans presented a plan for striping of the Township roads and is waiting for a final cost estimate from Duramark August 21, 2017.
- There may be a paving of a portion of Buffham Road in 2018, Evans will work with the County on further details.
- The mow tractor is 10 years old. A decision whether to keep it or trade it in is being researched. A new tractor is \$110K and trade in is approximately \$50K. If the tractor is replaced the preference would be to have a rotary head vs. the flail arm.
- If time allows, the slag bin will be moved.
- The Township needs to be diligent in removing the dead ash trees.
- Stuckey Road culvert replacement is about 2/3 complete. Back filling was being done on September 5, 2017. Vasel Brothers requested Evans deliver the check on Wednesday, September 6, 2017
- The cemetery was mowed to the creek line and weeds will be sprayed in the spring, 2018.
